マルバーン・カレッジ・グループ10校目として、2023年9月に英国ブランドとしては初のIB一貫校が開校することが決定し ました。

Malvern College Tokyo will be the seventh overseas school in the Malvern family, expanding Malvern's global network to a total of ten members in locations including the UK, Qingdao, Chengdu, Hong Kong, Egypt and Switzerland.

Malvern College Tokyo will open in September 2023 and aims to be a leading international school in Tokyo. Initially accommodating pupils from Years 1 to 9, this will extend upwards to Year 13 by 2026, ultimately providing 950 places for both primary and secondary pupils.

Located in the city of Kodaira, only a 40-minute commute from central Tokyo, Malvern College Tokyo aims to be the first all-through IB British-branded school in Tokyo. The school is located in a highly academic area of the city with many renowned establishments including Hitotsubashi University and Tsuda University nearby.

Continuing to expand its international portfolio of schools, Malvern College has chosen Tokyo, a 'world city' with consistent population growth for its tenth overseas school. Malvern College will work in unison with the Babylon education group who already manage three other schools within the Malvern College Family, including Malvern College Chengdu, Malvern College Hong Kong and Malvern College Hong Kong Prep Schools.

Founded in 1865, Malvern College is a leading co-educational boarding and day school based in Malvern, Worcestershire, UK. Together with its associated preparatory schools, The Downs Malvern and Abberley Hall, it provides a quality education for both boys and girls aged from 3 to 18 years.
