About the Role

- Develop and document standard operating procedures (SOPs), troubleshooting guides, and best practices .
- Evaluate and propose new AV technologies that align with the client's long-term AV strategy.
- Collaborate with IT leadership to enhance AV system security, compliance, and integration with corporate IT networks.
